



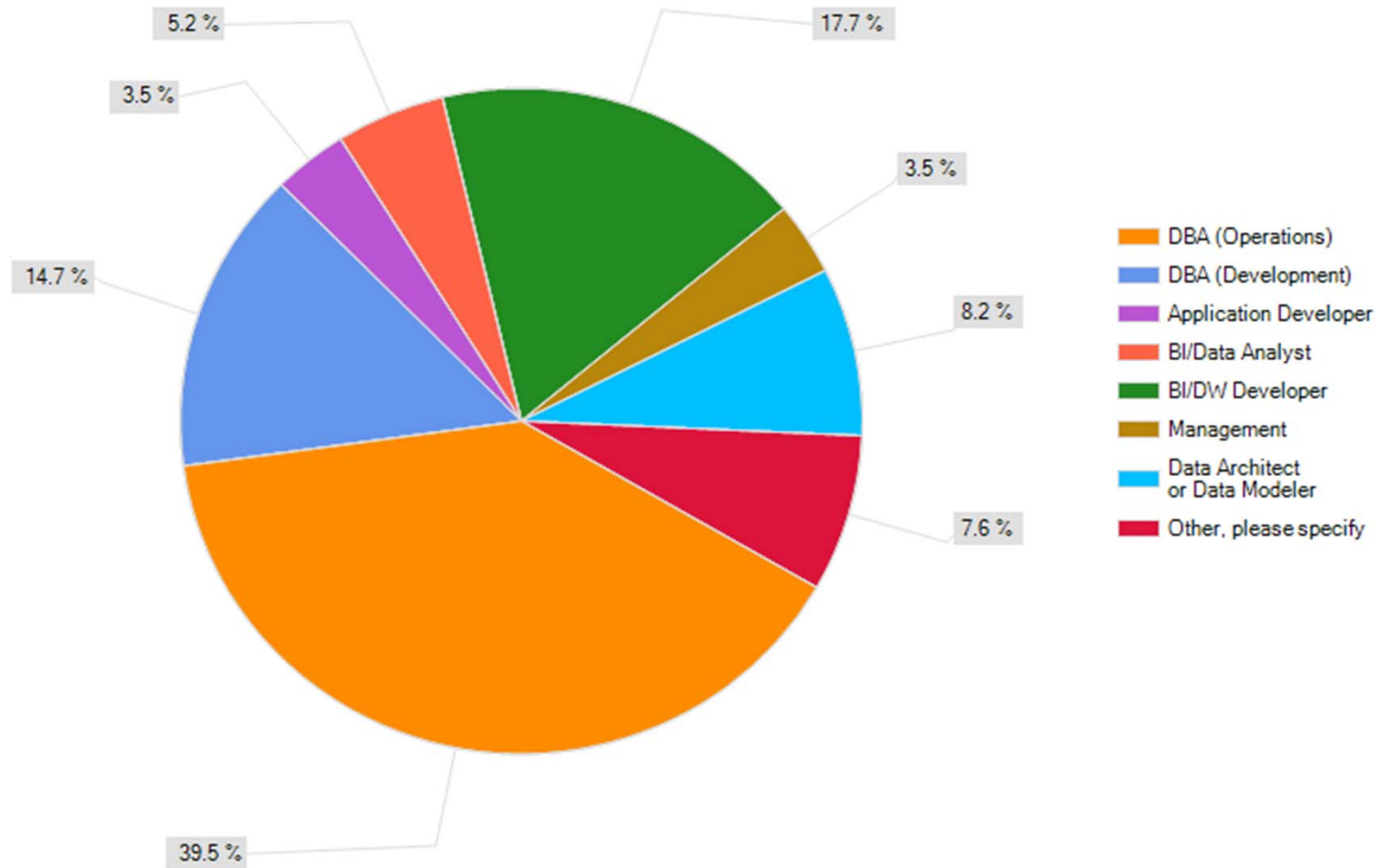

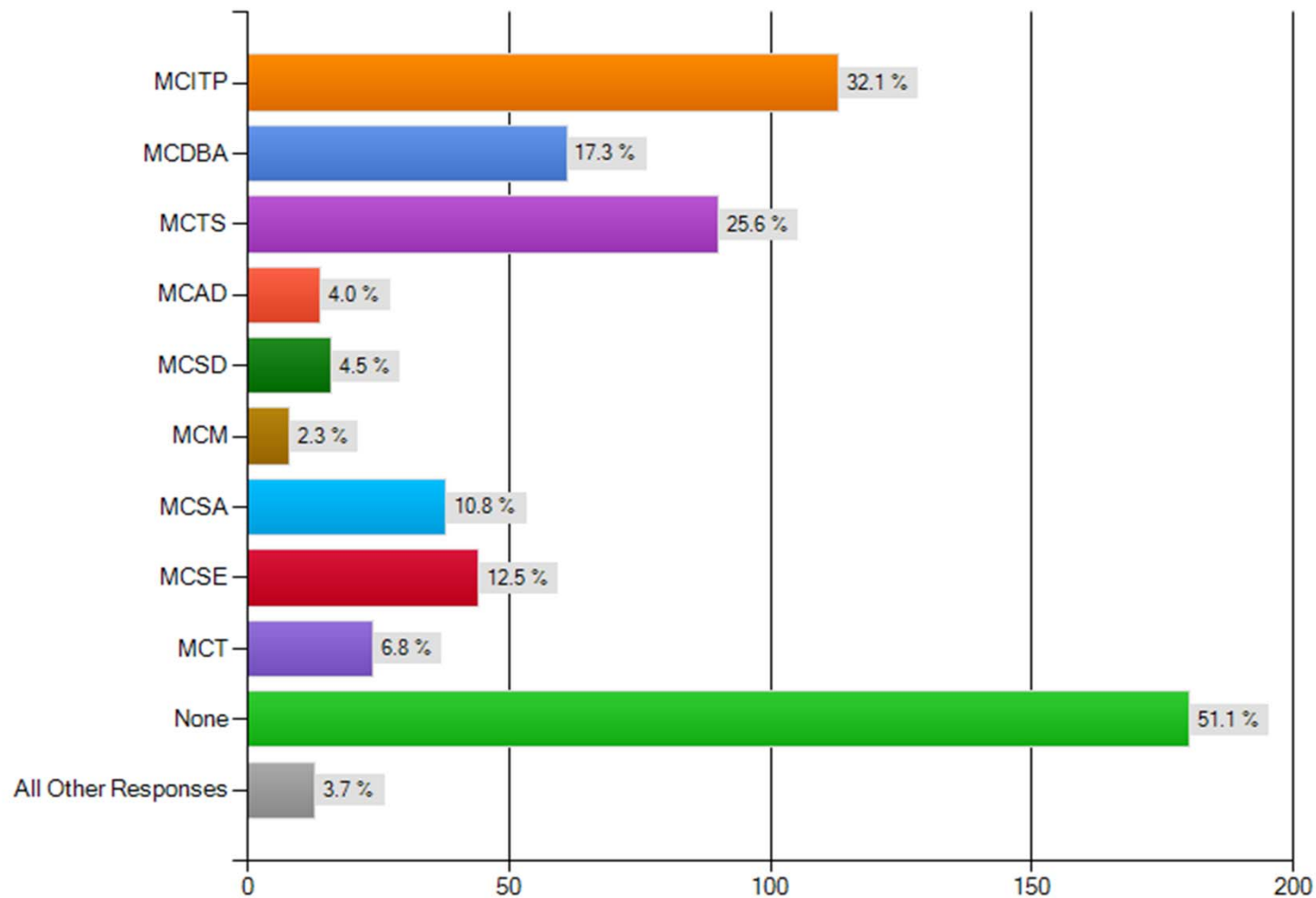

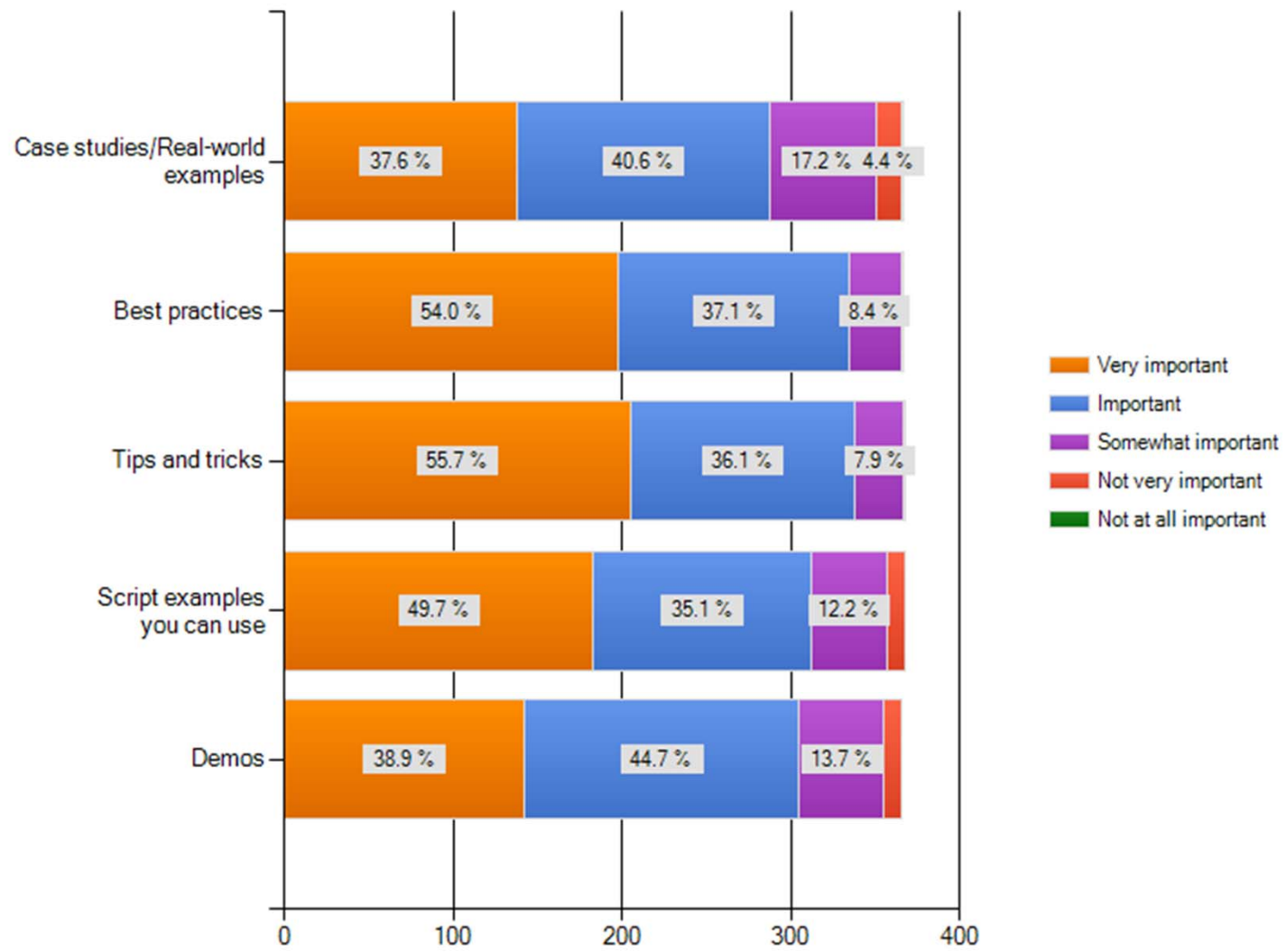
What job function best describes your main responsibilities?
